Racer Check-in: Bib pick-up will be in the Race Office. As you will keep your bib for all starts, daily check in is not required. When you complete your last race run, please return your bib to the finish line or to the Race Office. If you fail to return your bib, you will be assessed a fee of \$50.

Daily Schedules will be published. Any changes will be communicated by email and posted to the Team Snap race event.

Code of Conduct: All Participants are under FIS rules. As a reminder athletes must observe proper Code of Conduct.

Awards: Awards will be presented for top A, B, C categories, as well as a for Category D - best time of the day. These will be FIS Masters results, however, are not part of the FIS Master CUP results.

SL medals will be presented at the banquet. GS awards Sunday after the race and SG and Overall Awards will be presented after the tear down of the race on March 11th, outside of the Race Office.

Accommodations: Accommodations are the responsibility of the individual.

Mount Kidd Manor (Kananaskis Village)

There are a limited number of rooms (20 units) blocked off (March 7, 2024 check in – March 11, 2024 check out) at the [Mount Kidd Manor](#) that are available for athletes and race volunteers. Please contact the Nakiska hill manager, Jan Sekerak, at Jsekerak@skinakiska.com for booking. These are rooms with two queen beds, typically double occupancy, \$300/night/room. Mount Kidd Manor is a short 5 min drive to Nakiska ski hill. Cancellation available up to 30 days before check-in with no charge, after that date there will be a one night charge for cancellation. Please see the [Mount Kidd Manor](#) website for all available amenities. Ski tuning facilities are available on site.

Stoney Nakoka Resort and Casino (20 minutes from Nakiska)

Mid-week rate of \$129 and Friday/Saturday rate is \$149 plus applicable taxes. Preferred rates may be available at the Stoney Nakoda resort depending on availability. Room availability at the discounted rate is

Video

Getting to Nakiska:

If you are attending the [World Masters Criterium in Kimberley](#), we suggest that you fly into Calgary International Airport (YYC) and rent a car. Kimberley, BC is about a 4 hour drive through the beautiful Rocky Mountains via the TransCanada Highway and Highway 93.

When you finish racing in Kimberley, you will then drive back towards Calgary, hotels in either Banff (40 minutes to Nakiska), Canmore (30 minutes to Nakiska), or the Stoney Nakoda Resort (at Highway 40 turnoff – 20 minutes to Nakiska), or Mt. Kidd Manor (5min to Nakiska).

Nakiska is located on Highway 40 south of the TransCanada highway in the Kananaskis Provincial Park and requires a parking pass to park at the hill. Passes can be obtained from the visitors information center or [online](#).

After racing at Nakiska, you will have a 1 hour drive to the Calgary Airport.
