**Location / Course**: Nakiska Alpine Resort, Kananaskis, Alberta

Home of the 1988 Winter Olympics

MapMaker (FIS Homolgated), right off the top of the Gold Chair

The SG Race will conform to FIS Masters vertical and will have a running time of 70 – 80 seconds for the average racer. The GS run will have a running time of approximately 1 minute each run.

Sanction: Alberta Alpine / Alpine Canada / FIS

Friday March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024: SG Timed Training Runs (recommended) **Event Dates:** 

> Saturday March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024: two SL Races (each 2 run race) Sunday March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024: two GS Races (1 run race) Monday March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2024: two SG Races (1 run race)

Race schedule may change if conditions require reconsideration.

**Entry Deadline:** Entries will be accepted until 8:00am local time on Thursday February 29<sup>th</sup>,

2024. Any event not reaching a minimum of 40 entries by this date may

be canceled.

**U14 Entry Fee:** Following provincial guidelines for U14 Entries (includes AA fee)

> Unlimited SG Timed Training (March 8<sup>th</sup>): \$55 CAD 2 SL Races (March 9th): \$55/day 2 GS Races (March 10th): \$55/day 2 SG Races (March 11th): \$55/day

Code of Conduct: All Participants must adhere to the Alberta Alpine and Alberta Masters Ski

Club Code of Conduct.

Awards: Medals will be presented in Masters Age groups and for U16 and U14 for

each event.

Overall awards will be presented for top A, B, C, U16, and U14

based upon World Cup Points scoring.

FIS Masters result, not a FIS Master CUP result.

**Note:** this race will not have National Points Results for U16 or U14

athletes.

SL medals will be presented at the banquet. GS awards Sunday after the race and SG and Overall Awards will be presented after the tear down of

the race on March 11th, outside of the Race Office.

CMAT Points: CMAT Masters World Cup (WC) points will be awarded in the normal

> Masters' age categories for each SG race, the GS and the SL race (but not the alpine combined). Points count towards the Canadian Masters Alpine Team (CMAT) nomination for those having a Master's National or FIS card (weekend competitor cards do not qualify). For full details on CMAT

**Accommodations**: Accommodations are the responsibility of the individual.

#### Mount Kidd Manor (Kananaskis Village)

There are a limited number of rooms (20 units) blocked off (March 7, 2024 check in – March 11, 2024 check out) at the Mount Kidd Manor that are available for athletes and race volunteers. Please contact the Nakiska hill manager, Jan Sekerak, at Jserkerak@skinakiska.com for booking. These are rooms with two queen beds, typically double occupancy, \$300/night/room. Mount Kidd Manor is a short 5 min drive to Nakiska ski hill. Cancellation available up to 30 days before check-in with no charge, after that date there will be a one night charge for cancellation. Please see the Mount Kidd Manor website for all available amenities. Ski tuning facilities are available on site.

#### Stoney Nakoka Resort and Casino (20 minutes from Nakiska)

Mid-week rate of \$129 and Friday/Saturday rate is \$149 plus applicable taxes. Preferred rates may be available at the Stoney Nakoda resort depending on availability. #### **Getting to Nakiska:**

If you are attending the World Masters Criterium in Kimberley, we suggest that you fly into Calgary International Airport (YYC) and rent a car. Kimberley, BC is about a 4 hour drive through the beautiful Rocky Mountains via the TransCanada Highway and Highway 93.

When you finish racing in Kimberley, you will then drive back towards Calgary, hotels in either Banff (40 minutes to Nakiska), Canmore (30 minutes to Nakiska), or the Stoney Nakoda Resort (at Highway 40 turnoff – 20 minutes to Nakiska), or Mt. Kidd Manor (5min to Nakiska).

Nakiska is located on Highway 40 south of the TransCanada highway in the Kananaskis Provincial Park and requires a parking pass to park at the hill. Passes can be obtained from the visitors information center or online.

After racing at Nakiska, you will have a 1 hour drive to the Calgary Airport.
